

DAY 20 Our second last day –Bush camp to Norseman

We were on the road by 6.15am, our aim is to reach Norseman, a drive of 400 miles. “Merv” didn’t slow us down but left ahead of the group each time we stopped.

Each Roadhouse was a stop for fuel and a snack. At one of the stops “Merv” had a quick wheel alignment due to tyre wear which was becoming obvious.

We had to pull over at one stage due to a wide load. There were two low loaders each with Dump Truck bodies. Each was 8.4 m wide. The driver of one of the sign vehicles said there were 20 of these coming to WA at a cost of \$46,000 just for the transport cost each trip!

There was the compulsory stop at the border where they inspect for fruit etc.

We made Norseman by 6pm, all rather weary. This was our longest day of travel and we drove 660 Kms!
