KSO ON THE **A20** PAST NURIOOTPA, BLANCHETOWN, WAIKERIE, BARMERA & BERRI KSO TO FIRST NIGHT'S STOP IN RENMARK

<u>ACCOMMODATION</u> – Venturer Motel (Golden Chain) 234 Renmark Ave., the 2nd motel on your left hand side as you go in to town, directly opposite Big W. 08 85866841. Ask for your DISCOUNT VOUCHER – you can use it at other Golden Chain motels we stay at.

TUESDAY – DESTINATION - BALRANALD (APPROX 327KM, 202 MILES)

TL FROM MOTEL, BUT POSITION YOURSELVES IN THE RIGHT HAND LANE. 300m TR TO STAY ON THE STURT HWY (A20) – SIGNPOSTED TO MILDURA KSO STURT HIGHWAY TO MILDURA. (130kms approx.) **<u>REST TIME</u>** - Morning tea – Lunch. You may stop wherever you wish in Mildura for this, however if you would like to visit the highly regarded **Woodsies Gem Shop**, it is well worth while. They have a cafeteria, toilets for your comfort and other attractions.

<u>**To go to Woodsies**</u> - Following your nose into Mildura, you will enter the town on Deakin Ave which is the main road into town. Continue on this until you come to Eleventh Street, where you TR. (There are churches on each corner as you come to the lights). Watch for the dual lanes and traffic signals. Continue on Eleventh Street quite a way, crossing over the railway line, until you come to Morpung Avenue. TL and continue on it until the T Junction. TR into Cureton Ave, the parking area & gem shop is there on your right hand side.

Otherwise, the main shopping area is in the streets running to the left off Deakin Avenue past Eleventh Street. The river is at the end of Deakin Ave.

<u>MEETING POINT TO LEAVE MILDURA</u> – <u>1.00pm</u> down on the river on Hugh King Drive..(At the end of Deakin Ave. TR. TL at first street and park down near the river wherever you can; this is Hugh King Drive)

CROSS OVER THE MURRAY RIVER, STAYING ON THE STURT HWY, A20, AND CONTINUE ON TO GOL GOL & EUSTON (approx. 82 KMS).

<u>**REST TIME**</u> – If you wish, a short break could be had at Lake Benanee, 15 kms beyond Euston. This is right beside the road on the right hand side, has shady trees and toilets (from memory).

<u>**REST TIME**</u> – Somewhere in or near Hay for morning tea, wherever the person in front sees a nice stopping place.

NOTE: For those who need to buy lunch, it might be an idea to get it in Hay as the small towns along this road didn't have a lot going for them, from memory. Lunch stop around about midday wherever we happen to be.
