

## November run by Bob and Lorraine Piercy.

**Meet at Alderbury Reserve, Floreat**, near the corner of Perry Lakes Drive and Oceanic Drive at 9am for 9.30 start.

TR out of carpark into **Perry Lakes Drive**

TL into **Oceanic Drive** – proceed 500 metres

TR into **Bold Park Drive**

TL into **The Boulevard**, proceed to next roundabout

TR into **Durston Road**, continue on to T junction

TR into **Empire Avenue**, proceed 250 metres to next roundabout

TL into **Weaponess Road**, proceed 2 ½ Km to roundabout @ BRIGHTON RD

**Dogleg** – left then right, now in **Duke Street**

KSO across Scarborough Beach Road

TR at 2nd roundabout into **Sackville Terrace** - NO STREET SIGN

TL at Traffic Lights into **Huntress Road**

TR at Traffic Lights into **Karrinyup Road**

TL next Traffic lights into **North Beach Road**, KSO to next traffic lights

TL ( this is still North Beach Road ) **Follow North Beach Road** to next roundabout

Roundabout- take 2nd exit – **Duffy Road**- then ..

TL into **Reid Highway**, then in 1 Km...

TR at Traffic Lights into **Okely Road**

TL at Traffic Lights into **Beach Road**, KSO about 2 Km

TR at Traffic Lights into **Marmion Avenue**,

KSO, about 4 Km, cross Hepburn Avenue, then 2nd street on left....

TL into **Flinders Street**.

In 500 metres is our morning tea stop - **Mawson Park** – on right.

After Morning Tea.

Proceed back along **Flinders Street**

TL into **Marmion Avenue**

TL at traffic lights into **Whitfords Avenue**, go past shopping centre then..

TR at traffic lights into **Dampier Avenue**, proceed to the end of Dampier

TL into **Ocean Reef Road**. - KSO about 3 Km

TR at roundabout into **Shenton Avenue**- proceed 2Km

TL into **Connolly Drive** – KSO 8km-

TR at roundabout into **Hester Avenue** – proceed 2 km to Wanneroo Road

TL at **Wanneroo Road**., proceed 1km

TR into [REDACTED]

After 1km look for driveway on right – marked - [REDACTED]

Take driveway (slowly) up hill to the house, parking will be snug, but OK if we park neatly.

Our hosts will be [REDACTED] will show us through his private museum and collection of antique arms and armour.
