TL into Ennis Ave and go all the way to Mandurah

Go over Mandurah Estuary Bridge

Go over Port Bouvard Bridge

TL into Estuary Rd (scenic drive), car park and toilets at the bottom of the hill near the water

Continue along Estuary Rd until you reach the Old Coast Rd

TL into Old Coast Rd

TR into Mount John Rd and drive to you see Bouvard winery
