## Club Run, Sunday 15 March 2015

Starting Point: Piney Lakes Carpark. Destination: WAROONA. 9.00 am for a 9.30 am departure.

## KEY: SS - Stop Sign. GW - Give Way Sign. TLts - Traffic Lights. TJ - T Junction. TR - Turn Right. TL - Turn Left. KSO - Keep Straight On. RAbt - Roundabout.

Exit Piney Lakes Car park, TR into Murdoch Drive heading south. TLts at South Street, KSO. (70 kph). TLts, KSO. TLts, KSO. RAbt, KSO.

At the next RAbt take first exit left into Farrington Road. Cross over Kwinana Freeway (60 kph). Pass through four small RAbts, staying on Farrington Road.

TLts at TJ – TR into Karel Avenue. RAbt, KSO. Cross Roe Highway staying in Karel Avenue. RAbt, KSO. RAbt – take second exit left into Berrigan Drive (South Lake).

RAbt – take first exit left into Jandakot Road. RAbt – TR (third exit) into Warton Road. TLts at TJ, TL into Armadale Road.

At TLts TR into Nicholson Road. TJ, TL into Thomas Road. TR into Kargotich Road (the next right after Rice Road). Head south along Kargotich Road.

SS – TL into Mundijong Road. 60 kph. TL into Paterson Street, the main street in Mundijong. CAUTION: Major road works on this street! Proceed along Paterson Street to the Railway Station, Public Toilets and Children's Playground – on the right side of Paterson Street opposite IGA and Liquor Store. Try to find parking near the toilets. There are covered picnic/barbecue areas along from the playground via a good wide pathway. Very limited parking near the picnic area because of the road works. Morning Tea Stop. (Total distance: about 40 km (25 miles)– 45 to 50 minutes travel time).

Depart Mundijong, head south along Paterson Street to GW at TJ. TL into Watkins Road (Mundijong Road is on your right).

SS at TJ. TR onto South West Highway – 40 km (25 miles) to Pinjarra. (If required, there are toilets at Pinjarra Railway Station on left before the bridge). Proceed through Pinjarra to Waroona. (25 kms – 12 miles.)

The Lunch Stop is at Drakesbrook Centennial Park which is on the right, about two thirds of the way through Waroona. TR into Birch Street, which is immediately after De Hamel Street. Park nose in toward the park picnic tables and a covered area (rotunda).
