

SUNDAY 20TH JULY 2025 - RUN TO GIDGEGANNUP

This drive takes you from the historic heart of Guildford to the scenic Gidgegannup Showgrounds, following a winding path through the Swan Valley and the rolling hills beyond via Brigadoon. It's just over 50kms in distance and should take a good 1hr and half. We don't have any planned stops along the way as it's a relatively short run, however if you need a loo stop we suggest maybe stopping before you turn off the Great Northern Highway as there is not much beyond there until you reach Gidgegannup

There are some very steep hills and tight bends so no need to speed and hope your brakes are working well

Watch out for kangaroos.

Depart approx. 10.30am

Assemble at Guildford war memorial park, Stirling Street Guildford
(Behind Alfreds Kitchen)

Exit left into Meadow Street at roundabout (1st exit)

Continue through roundabout which now becomes West Swan Road
State route 52.

Cross over Swan River bridge.

Take the second exit at roundabout to continue past Benara Road.

Take the second exit at the roundabout to continue past Arthur Street.

At Reid Highway traffic lights continue straight and continue on West Swan Road.

At Gnangara Road roundabout take the second exit to continue on
state route 52 West Swan Road.

At Milhouse road roundabout take the second exit and continue on
West Swan Road. *(you need right lane to take 2nd exit)*

At traffic lights (T-junction) turn right into great northern highway
national route 1.

Cross over Swan River bridge.

In about a mile, Turn left into Cathedral Avenue (*big blue sign "State Equestrian Centre / Bells Rapids 3.5"*)

In about 1.5miles - Turn right into Camargue Drive. (*just past Volunteer Bushfire Brigade Shed on your right*)

Cross over railway line.

At T-junction turn left into Campersic road (*slow incline*)

At the first roundabout take the second exit to Boulonnais Drive. (*very steep down hill – but check out the view*) this is a scenic loop that will bring you back onto Campersic Rd.

At the first roundabout take the first exit onto Campersic Road.

Turn right onto Connemara Drive.

(*there may be a No Thru Rd sign – ignore this and continue*)

At the first roundabout take the first exit onto Lancewood Avenue. (*very steep hills*)

At T-junction turn left onto O'Brien Road. (*very tight bends*)

At the base of hill (approx. 10km) cross the one lane bridge over Wooroloo Brook when safe.

Once past Ewing Road (*small road sign on left*) keep straight on (*veering to the right*) as O'Brien Road becomes Clenton Road.

In the gully, on your left you will see the Peter Brock Memorial on left. continue along Clenton Road. (*be mindful of kangaroos along here*)

At T-junction, turn right onto Berry Road.

In about 2miles, Turn right into Reserve Road. (*no street sign – its just over Equitus Brook – immediate right*)

At T-junction, turn left into Toodyay Road. (*short steep downhill before stopping at T-Junction*)

Go past Shell Garage on your left and just before Gidgegannup Bakery turn left into Old Toodyay Road. (opp Bunning Rd)

Keep straight on and enter showgrounds on left just before the bend.

Park near the hall.
