

SUN, JULY 19TH RUN – MODEL A RESTORER'S CLUB OF W.A.

Start – 10.00am.

TL from Stirling St onto Meadow St, and TR (3rd exit) on the roundabout into Swan St.

Take 1st exit on next roundabout into Terrace Road and keep going; it morphs into Gt. Eastern Hwy. at the railway crossing lights. FYN straight through Midland and out the other side, considering all traffic rules as you go. Up the hill and into Mundaring townsite.

FYN until you get to the lights at Stoneville Rd, where you will TL on the green light. You will pass these streets along the way: Walker, Hillcrest, Breckler, Milligan, Jarrah.

Roundabout at Riley Rd; take 3rd exit into that road.

TJ – TL; Sexton Rd; TJ – TR – you should now be in Keane St. West. FYN until you come into Mt. Helena township. Ahead of you is the

Morning Tea stop - If fine weather, park around the Pioneer Park in town, bounded by Keane, McVicar, Sawyers/Keane St. East. Head into the park for your cuppa and biccie. Aim for about 20 mins max stop here. If wet, read instructions at top of page.

Restarting – head for the roundabout on the edge of the park and take the Keane St. East road eastwards. (Lake Leschenaultia/Chidlow sign).

TR at Lion St. TL at Elliott Rd, which morphs into Thomas St. at Chidlow.

Just past the Chidlow tavern, take the 1st exit into Old Northam Rd. FYN again for a while. Keep an eye out and on the top of the T- junction with Government Rd, TR, continuing on in Old Northam Road. (If you end up in Wooroloo, you should have turned earlier!!)

T-Junction – Great Eastern Hwy. TL when safe to do so. Exercise safety as you drive through Baker's Hill and Clackline.

Getting closer to Northam, pass the Northam Army Camp on right. Keep an eye out for your next turn R, at the Northam/York & RV signs, into Mitchell Ave. (no street sign). FYN down the road, past the Yongah Hill IDC entrance (on R), Mt. Ommanney lookout on your left, under the rail bridge, staying on Mitchell as you negotiate roundabouts, etc.

T Junction, TR at Newcastle Rd., and cross over the Avon river. TL at Fitzgerald Street. FYN along Fitzgerald until you get to the roundabout at Grey Street. TL 1st exit into Grey St.

TR into Minson St and almost immediately, TL into the car park on the left and park near the loo's, especially if you are in hurry! You have reached your destination – Bernard Park.

You can see the loo, behind it is a gazebo and beyond that towards the river is a structure with a couple of tables in it (not the music shell to the right). Lunch and Meeting place.

After the meeting, cruise around the town if you wish. The second-hand/antique shop should be open in Fitzgerald St. near the APO, for those who want a wander. Head home whenever you want, by whichever route is good for you.
